

Woking 50+ Club Walk - Bushy Park
Wednesday 19 May 2021

Meeting point – Hurst Meadows Minor Car Park on Graburn Way, East Molesey KT8 9AL (OS Explorer 161 grid ref TQ149689).

Time - 10am.

Distance - approximately 4 miles

Directions - From Cobham on A3 take Portsmouth Road, A307. Drive through Esher and at Scilly Isles roundabout turn left onto A309 towards Hampton Court. Immediately before Hampton Court Bridge and opposite the station turn left and follow the road round with the river on the right. A short distance along turn right into the Hurst Meadows Minor Car Park on Graburn Way.

Alternatively - at Walton Bridge take the A3050 towards Hampton Court which eventually becomes the Hurst Road. Turn left into Graburn Way and immediately left into the car park.

Note - there is a height restrictive barrier into the car park but there is parking available in the nearby roads.

The walk - Along the Thames Path then through the grounds of Hampton Court Palace and into Bushy Park. The terrain is flat although it could be a little muddy. The coffee stop will be in the Water Garden where seats are available. The toilets are not situated in a helpful manner in the park and it is possible that you will need a 20p coin to access them.

Lunch - not arranged.

Dogs - sorry but dogs are not welcome on 50+ walks.

First Aid - the walk leader will carry a basic first aid kit and a mobile phone in case of minor accidents.
