Fetcham Downs

Start: 10.00 am: Fetcham car park, just off the roundabout on the A246, nearest postcode KT22 9BW (OS Explorer map 146 grid ref TQ150549)

Directions: From M25 / A3 at Cobham travel through Cobham, Stoke d'Abernon and Fetcham. After going under the railway bridge in Fetcham fork right into The Street and follow the road round with church on right and go straight on to the roundabout as noted above. Please note there is a voluntary car park charge levied by Surrey Wildlife Trust of just under £4 which is to help in the clearance of the trees suffering from ash die back.

The Walk: Approximately 4.5 miles over Fetcham Downs, Norbury Park, Crabtree Lane and Bookham Wood. Lovely far reaching views. Sections of the route could be very muddy if there has been prolonged rain.

Lunch: Sir Douglas Haig in Effingham.

SORRY, NO DOGS Because of possible trip and fall hazard that dogs present to our walkers, we regret dogs are no longer welcome to join 50+ walks.

First Aiders: The walk leader will carry a **basic** first aid kit and a mobile phone in case of minor accidents, though mobile coverage is limited in this area. It is expected that all walkers will be prepared for the conditions. However, if any walker is a qualified first aider, would they make themselves known to the walk leader before the start.
