CUTT MILL, PUTTENHAM COMMON AND THE TARN

Meeting Point: The Top Car Park, Puttenham Common SU 920 461

Time: Walk Starts at 10 am

Distance: 5 miles

Directions: Take the A3 and after Guildford turn onto the A31 (Hoggs Back). Take next turn-off the B3000 towards Puttenham (turning left off slip road). Take 1st Right (The Street), go past church and take Left opposite The Good Intent Pub into Suffield Lane. Car Park is approximately 1 mile on the Right.

The Walk: The walk is through woodland and heath going past Cutt Mill Pond, The Tarn and Generals Pond to the North Downs Way below The Hoggs Back. There is one steep descent and one steep hill and a long moderate incline. There are no stiles.

As with all walks please wear suitable footwear especially if it has been wet as it could be muddy in places.

First Aiders: The walk leaders will carry a basic first aid kit and mobile phone in case of minor accidents and it is expected that all walkers be prepared for the conditions. If any walker is a qualified first aider, would they please make themselves known to walk leaders before the start.

Dogs: Sorry, but because of possible trip and fall hazard that dogs present to our walkers, we regret dogs are no longer welcome to join 50+ walks.
