

**50 + CLUB WALK - Wednesday, 16th July, 2025**

**Distance:** About 7 km / 4.5 miles

**Meeting:** 10:00 am

Car Park on L.H.S. Shere Road . OS map 145 Ref. 0855141

**Directions:** One alternative is to go via Ripley. Turn down Rose Lane leading on to Ripley Lane and continue (quite a way!) to the end where Ripley Lane meets The Street at West Horsley. Turn Right along The Street and continue to a roundabout where The Street meets the A246. Cross over the roundabout into Shere Road. The Car Park is about 1km up the road on LHS.

Alternatively come via Send & West Clandon and joining the A246 (Epsom Road) towards Leatherhead. At the West Horsley roundabout (by the Bell & Coalvill car showrooms) turn RIGHT into Shere Road. The Car Park is about 1km up the road on LHS.

**The Walk:** This is a repeat of the first walk I ever did for 50+ several years ago. Mostly along bridle paths with a couple of hills no stiles, but possibly quite muddy in places, especially through the wood yard after wet weather, so **suitable footwear is essential**. Mixed terrain and views, with a possible sighting of the Wembley arch on a clear day.

**Lunch:** I have provisionally booked for 10 at the King William 4th at West Horsley. From car park go back down Shere Road, straight over the roundabout on A246 into The Street. The King William (KT24 6BG) is number 83, about 0.5 km on LHS.

**Dogs** -Sorry but Dogs are not welcome on 50+ walks

**First Aiders:** The walk leader will carry a **basic** first aid kit and a mobile phone in case of minor accidents, though mobile coverage is limited in this area. It is expected that all walkers will be prepared for the conditions. However, if any walker is a qualified first aider, would they make themselves known to the walk leader before the start.
