HORSELL COMMON - DEEP POOL AND THE WETLANDS

MEETING POINT: The Cricketers public house, Horsell Birch, Woking GU21 4XB. Plenty of parking at the rear. From Woking pass the World Wildlife Centre on Brewery Road, turn right at the roundabout to climb Church Hill into the village and continue down the High Street until you reach the pub on the left where the houses end and the common begins.

THE WALK: About 4 miles across common land, on footpaths and country lanes. We will take care in crossing three or four roads.

As usual, the walk commences at 10.00 and we will take a coffee break after approximately one hour.

LUNCH: I will inform the pub that some [most?] of our party will eat there afterwards, which will ensure they are happy that we use their car park.

N.B: A local village walking group meets in front of The Cricketers at 10.00 every Wednesday. Make sure you get with the 50+ group!!

FIRST AID: As is customary on these walks, a member will be carrying a small first aid kit and a mobile phone. It is expected that all walkers will be prepared for the weather conditions encountered, and must inform the walk leader, before setting out, of any health issues the leader should be aware of.
