WOKING 50+ CLUB WEDNESDAY WALK

Wednesday 20th November 2024

Wisley Airfield and Common

Meeting point: Mill Lane, between Ripley and Wisley Gardens. From Woking drive through Send to the roundabout junction with the B2215, turning left through Ripley and on to the roundabout junction with the A3. Go straight on at the roundabout as if heading towards the A3 and Wisley Gardens, but immediately take a left turn into Mill Lane, which is also signposted to The Wisley Golf Club. Park here at the roadside where there is a small layby.

Time: 10.00am start **Distance:** About 4.25 miles, two hours plus a refreshment stop

Warning: this walk includes just one stile and is predominantly level, with just one steady incline.

The walk: a dry walk with very few nettles or brambles. It includes the old tarmac runway, an air traffic navigation beacon, a semaphore tower, a coffee stop where coffee and snacks can also be bought, Bolder Mere and a return to the old runway for the final section.

Lunch; The Seven Stars in Newark Lane Ripley is just 10 minutes from the end of the walk and offers a varied lunch menu.

Dogs; Regrettably because of the trip and fall hazard that they can sometimes present to our members, dogs cannot accompany us on our 50+ walks..

First Aid; The walk leader will carry a basic first-aid kit and a mobile phone in case of minor accidents, although mobile coverage is limited on parts of this route. It is expected that all walkers will be prepared for the weather and ground conditions encountered and should inform walk leaders before setting out of any health issues which they should be made aware of.
